\*Old Business

1. Adjustments made to April minutes. #5 – Interviewing for Cindy's position should be deleted. That position is incorporated into the position noted in #8. Delete #5. Revise the Education report from Pat Shapiro to read "Upcoming meeting will focus on the topic of school families and the Parish School Project, honoring tuition commitments as well as volunteer hours. Choice families are not obligated by law to do fundraising. St. G's does get fully paid tuition under Choice." Maureen Unora will make these changes and submit to Tom Bremier, our webmaster, for placement on the website.
2. Parking Lot – Patching was done by parish volunteers, with a savings to the parish. The patch work is expected to last for at least one year.

1. Fr. Tom has hired the pastoral associate. Her name is Chiara Sainer and she will start on June 28, 2010.
2. The part-time Life Teen Director position has been posted on the archdiocese website. We continue to search for a Music Director.
3. Gina Kuemmel has asked for volunteers from the current parish council to participate in the Discernment process on May 25<sup>th</sup>.
4. Fr. Tom will be meeting with a liturgical consultant regarding options for the refurbishing of the front of the church.
5. Patti Penkaski walked the council through the budget. The council felt the Budget and Finance committees did their due diligence and provided a realistic and balanced budget as was possible. Therefore, the budget was approved by the Parish Council.

\*Pat – Education: 5K is on the rise. Kindergarten has outgrown their current space and a review team is looking to move them back into the main school area.
